Program Aides – The largest leadership program for girls in Girl Scouts of Western Washington is the Program Aide experience. Girls entering 7th Grade and older may be eligible to participate. Program Aides are Girl Scouts who have attended a GSWW-provided workshop and spend the week of camp working with groups of younger girls, under adult supervision. Some camps offer the workshop during the camp session.

Program Aides also have opportunities to plan and design program activities. Every summer, as many as 1000 teenagers participate in this leadership development program. See the camp description for age limits and registration fees.

Due to the high volume of girls that would like to PA for Camp Oh Ah Lay Lay we have an application process. Applications need to be turned in by May 15, 2012. Please see the Camp Website for the application.

How to register—Complete the registration form and mail it with full payment (unless using Cookie Dough or Financial Assistance) to: Camp Oh Ah Lay Lay 4002 Pacific Ave, Tacoma WA 98418. If requesting Financial Assistance, include a \$25 deposit – financial assistance will not reimburse this deposit, it is a family responsibility. Do not send your registration form to the DuPont of Seattle Girl Scout Centers.

Volunteering - Our community day camp is volunteer led. We are always looking for volunteers to help make this the successful camp that it is. Please contact Campohahlaylay@gmail.com if you are interested in volunteering. We would be happy to help you enhance girls lives. Volunteers receive a discount based on their volunteer time. All volunteers are interviewed and background checked. We have a place for YOU!

Girl Scout Membership – All girls participating in day/twilight camp must be registered as Girl Scouts. If your daughter is not currently a Girl Scout, include an additional \$12.00 with your payment to cover Girl Scout membership through 9/30/2012.

Camp Fees – the fees for our camps vary due to differences in locations and activities. A more expensive site fee, or special program offerings will impact the cost of the camp.

Using Cookie Dough or Cookie Camperships—If your daughter has earned Cookie Dough or a Cookie Day/Twilight Campership (450 boxes sold) through the Girl Scout Cookie Program, indicate this form of payment on the registration form. If you have received your Cookie Dough card, include the card number on the

form. If you have not received your 2010 Cookie Dough Card yet, leave the number space blank and notify the registrar when you have received the card number.

Financial Assistance—Girl Scouts of Western Washington grants financial assistance to currently registered girls based on financial need. Girls may request Financial Assistance for one camp session per year, up to 6 days in length. Girls may choose one of the following, Resident Camp, River Ranch Day Camp, Community Day or Twilight Camp, Community Resident Camp or Family Camp.

Before making any requests, a Financial Assistance eligibility form must be completed and returned to the GSWW DuPont Girl Scout Center. Request forms may be sent with eligibility form. Eligibility form must be submitted each year (Program year runs from Oct 1 through Sept 30).

The deadline for Financial Assistance Request forms is 30 days before the event for with assistance is being requested. This deadline will be enforced since applications are sometimes returned due to errors, incompleteness, or lack of signature. No retroactive financial assistance will be granted for programs in which a girl or adult has already participated. Notification of a girl's Day/Twilight camp grant will be sent to the girl's parent/guardian and the camp registrar, unless otherwise notified.

Refund/Cancellation Policy—Any request for a refund must be made to the camp director in writing. Full refunds will not be given after June 1, 2012.
